< *Hibiscus kokio* ssp. *saintjohnianus*
This breathtaking hibiscus is endemic to northwestern Kaua'i, Hawai'i

> *Viola lanaiensis* is disappearing in its natural habitat due to invasion by alien plants and animals.



< *Brighamia insignis*
NTBG's propagators are growing this plant by the hundreds. The last survey recorded only one plant left in the wild.

< *Kanaloa kahoolawensis*
This genus was discovered amidst unexploded bombs on the island of Kaho'olawe.

> *Tabebuia ochrasea*
This flowering tree attracts large populations of pollinators.
