This position (full time-40 hours per week) will primarily work in the Visitor/Education Center and within Kahanu Garden. The main purpose of this position is to ensure the work and mission of Kahanu Garden and the National Tropical Botanical Garden (NTBG) is properly communicated to guests, education groups, volunteers, and members of the community. Visitor Program associates are ambassadors, and will become effective advocates for the conservation of plants, natural areas, biocultural diversity and perpetuation of cultural knowledge.
